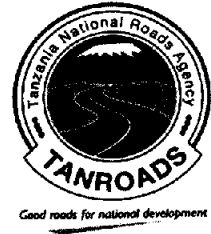

3.0 OPENING

The Chairperson, Eng. Baraka J. Mwambage opened the meeting at 09:02 hours by welcoming the participants to the meeting and requested them to introduce themselves. He thereafter informed them that questions will be responded during

site visit and wrap-up meeting to be held at Chalinze - Msolwa Petrol Station Hall. The participants were informed that the Technical Advisor (TA) representatives will give brief on scope of the project. A total of nineteen (19) Bidders' representatives attended the meeting and site visit as indicated in an attendance attached under **Appendix 1**.

4.0 BRIEFING ON SCOPE OF THE PROJECT

The welcoming remarks was followed by providing project briefing on scope of the project. Eng Shim Jang Hoon one of the TA's representatives gave a brief presentation on the project and explained the areas that will be visited during the site visit. He informed the participants that site visit will include stops at several locations of interest along the project route. He clarified that a total of 10 points/location will be visited in the course of the visit from Kibaha to Chalinze.

5.0 SITE VISIT

Site visit covered ten (10) sites/locations starting from Kibaha to Chalinze. Bidders were shown all interested areas. Queries raised during the Site visit were recorded and responded to accordingly. The locations are as follows: -

Location No.	Description	Remarks
1	Kibaha Interchange	This was at Kibaha Picha ya Ndege close to Lake oil petrol station. This is where the planned Kibaha trumpet type Interchange will be constructed. Transaction Advisor (TA) explained that the interchange was planned based on the fact that the existing Morogoro road is expected to be widen to a 6-lane.
2	TAZAMA oil pipe & High-Tension electric wires	At this location the project road will cross TAZAMA oil pipe line and the bidders were also shown. Also, we visited the High-tension electric wires. According to TANESCO's advise high-tension electric wires at this point will be raised up instead relocation.
3	Overpass on the existing road at Misugusugu area	Overpass is expected to be constructed at this location; Misugusugu. It was explained that the crossing is expected to be a bridge with a height of 8 metre.

4	Overpass on the existing road at the Industrial area	Overpass is expected to be constructed at this location. The crossing is expected to be a bridge with a height of 10 metres.
5	Mlandizi Interchange	The diamond type of interchange is expected to be constructed at Mlandizi site.
6	Ruvu area (Overpass on Morogoro road)	At this point the project road is expected to cross the existing Morogoro road. The crossing was expected to be a bridge with a height of 10 metres. According to TANESCO's advise an electric wire at this point will be to be raised up instead relocation.
7	Ruvu river bridge	A big bridge in this lot is expected to be Constructed. It was by the TA's representative that, the expected length of the bridge is 150 metres and the height of the bridge from the top of the river is 10 metres. It was also pointed out that there is another stream crossing the project road and it crosses within Ruvu JKT military camp.
8	Overpass at Major Gauge Railway (MGR)	Major Gauge Railway (MGR) crosses the project road at a location that was not seen during the site visit due to rain water but the TA explained to bidders that, the Project Road crossing the existing MGR at 800m from where we stopped and explained to the bidders that the crossing will be by bridge of height 12 metres. It was further clarified that a major rest area where the road users will be enjoying refreshing and other human activities was also expected to be around this point.
9	Vigwaza Interchange	The team visited at the point a trumpet type interchange will be constructed. This will connect with the existing roundabout that heads to the newly constructed Kwala dry port.
10	Chalinze Interchange	The site visit ended at this point where a diamond type interchange will be constructed and a toll plaza that will connect to Chalinze – Segera – Tanga (T2 road) and the mainline that crosses T2 road with a bridge of height 11 metres.

6. WRAP-UP MEETING

Following the site visit there was a wrap-up meeting that was held at Msolwa Petrol Station Hall. The Regional Manager, TANROADS Coast, Eng. Baraka J. Mwambage, opened the meeting and asked participants to introduce themselves and sign the attendance. He asked the PPP Manager, Eng Harold M. Kitainda to give brief leading to project implementation and thereafter invite the PPP Commissioner, Mr. David Kafulila for remarks. The participants signed Attendance Register is attached as **Appendix I** of the Minutes.

The PPP Commissioner thanked all bidders for showing up interest to participate in pre-qualification process and attending the site visit and also encouraged them to seek any clarifications they need in preparation of their applications. He also emphasized that transparency will be prioritized in all stages of procurement.

An Economist Mr. Alfred Missana, from Ministry of Finance and Planning also participated the wrap-up meeting.


Bidders raised various queries regarding the Request for Qualifications (RFQs) document and scope of the project, the same were recorded and responded to accordingly. However, for clarity bidders were requested to submit their queries in writing. Bidders were also reminded to submit additional queries or requests for clarification, if any, within the period stipulated in the RFQs.


The questions/issues raised and the corresponding responses/clarifications are included in **Appendix II** attached herewith.

7. CLOSING OF THE MEETING

The meeting was closed at 15:45hrs, the PPP Commissioner thanked all participants for their attendance and active participation in both the Pre-Applications Meeting and Site visit and assured that all questions /issues raised during Meeting and Site visit as well as others submitted in writing will be clarified.
